	<p>Route 3: Around the Earth</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Columbus thought he could sail west for 2,000 miles from Europe to Asia.• The Portuguese wouldn't pay for the trip.• Eventually Ferdinand and Isabella of Spain agreed to pay for the voyage.• He left in August 1492 with 3 ships.• After 2 months his crew threatened to mutiny.• On October 12 they spotted land.• Columbus thought they were the islands off the coast of India.• Columbus called the land the "Indies" and the people "Indians".• He had actually landed in the Caribbean.• He died in 1506 still believing he found Asia. <p>Ferdinand Magellan</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Led 1st voyage around the world (circumnavigate).• He left with 5 ships and 250 men.• He found a strait at the tip of South America.• Three years later, one ship of spices and 18 people returned.• Magellan wasn't one of them. <p>Results of Exploration</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The rise of capitalism (investing money hoping to make a profit).• Better world maps• Colonization of the Americas• Chocolate, corn, and tobacco were introduced to Europe from the Americas.• Horses were brought to America by the Europeans.• Missionaries spread religion and European languages.• Destruction of Native populations
