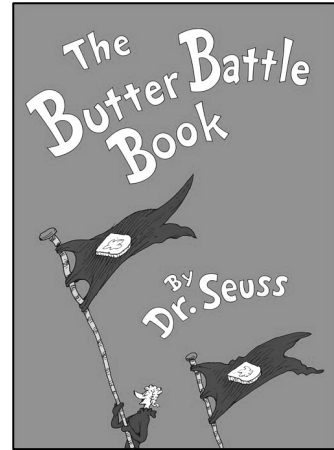


Picture Book
