	<p>Essential Question: What can artifacts from Pompeii tell us about Roman society?</p> <p>Roman Citizenship</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Being a citizen meant:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- legal rights- respect- wealth- voting rights <p>Roman Entertainment</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Entertainment was free for everyone in the Empire, not just citizens.• The Empire wanted to keep the people distracted.• If they were having fun they might not complain about their problems! <p>Roman Religion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Romans worshipped many gods (Jupiter their main god)• Jesus' life and death changed everything.• Within 50 years, Christianity had spread across the Empire. <p>Roman Food</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fish, apples, bread, milk-fed snails, doormice, rotting meat.• Because of the size of the empire, Romans could get a wide variety of foods. <p>Roman Language</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Latin was the language of Romans• Many modern languages come from Latin. (English, French, Italian, Spanish, etc.)
