	<p data-bbox="592 465 788 497">Entertainment</p> <ul data-bbox="639 504 1406 674" style="list-style-type: none">• Entertainment was free for everyone in the Empire, not just citizens.• The Empire wanted to keep the people distracted.• If they were busy having fun they might not notice all the problems! <p data-bbox="592 719 826 750">Roman Provinces</p> <ul data-bbox="639 757 1390 1070" style="list-style-type: none">• Lands conquered by the Romans were called “provinces”.• They made Rome rich so the Romans tried to keep them happy.• Rome provided:<ul data-bbox="730 936 1050 1070" style="list-style-type: none">– Entertainment– a system of laws– water from aqueducts– Protection <p data-bbox="592 1115 740 1146">Citizenship</p> <ul data-bbox="639 1153 1027 1323" style="list-style-type: none">• Being a citizen meant:<ul data-bbox="730 1182 1027 1323" style="list-style-type: none">– legal rights– respect– wealth– hold office and vote <p data-bbox="592 1368 820 1400">Roman Economy</p> <ul data-bbox="639 1406 1390 1503" style="list-style-type: none">• Provinces provided gold, slaves, and any other resources for trade.• In the 1st century about 20% of people were slaves.
